TRAVEL

The Moscow Institute of Physics and Technology (MIPT) is situated in the town of Dolgoprudny 18 km north of Moscow. Visa, Mastercard and other cards are accepted for payment almost everywhere. There are also currency exchange offices, where one can draw money / exchange cash currency for roubles.
